

**MCADENVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
SPECIAL METING / BUDGET WORK SESSION
MARCH 21, 2019**

The McAdenville Town Council met in Special Session on February 21, 2019 at 5:00 PM in the Conference Room of McAdenville Town Hall, 163 Main Street. Proper notice was given

Members Present: Mayor Jim Robinette and Councilmembers: Carrie Bailey, Joe Rankin, Mayor Pro-tem Jay McCosh and Reid Washam. Also present: Town Administrator/Clerk Lesley Dellinger. Councilmember Greg Richardson was out of town on business.

Mayor Robinette called the meeting to order. He stated the purpose of the meeting was to review and discuss the preliminary budget estimates for FY2019-20 and provide direction to staff.

Lesley Dellinger presented the 2019 property revaluation information provided by Gaston County and explained how it would impact the property tax revenues in the FY19-20 budget. The preliminary revenue neutral calculation was presented and Councilman Washam reviewed the General Statute requirements that govern the statement of this rate. Staff presented Council with projections for General Fund expenditures and requested feedback on allocations and additional projects. Following discussion, Council provided recommend changes to proposed allocations and requested that funding for the following projects be considered: additional street lighting along Main Street, sidewalk replacement on Wesleyan Drive from the traffic circle to carwash, upgrade sections of regulatory street signage, addition of Legacy Park fencing, expand community event sponsorship, purchase solar radar sign for entrance to Town at Hickory Grove Road, and earmark funds for the future canoe launch and Carolina Thread Trail connection to Cramerton.

There being no further business to discuss the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 6:38 PM.
