



Dear McAdenville Residents,

The Town of McAdenville recently learned that its sanitation contractor is unable to continue delivering recyclables to a recycling center for processing. This means that the contents of recycling bins rolled to the curb will now be taken to the landfill.

This unfortunate news is not of our contractor's choosing but rather part of a much bigger challenge affecting Towns across our region and around the country. This matter is largely the result of China's recent decision to drastically reduce the recyclables it accepts from the U.S. in response to U.S. households placing too many items in recycling bins that do not belong there.

Our town is diligently working to find a solution. In the interim, we encourage you to take your recycling to one of Gaston County's residential recycling centers for processing.
