

**MCADENVILLE TOWN COUNCIL  
SPECIAL METING / BUDGET WORK SESSION  
APRIL 25, 2019**

The McAdenville Town Council met in Special Session on April 25, 2019 at 5:00 PM in the Conference Room of McAdenville Town Hall, 163 Main Street. Proper notice was given

Members Present: Mayor Jim Robinette and Councilmembers: Carrie Bailey, Mayor Pro-tem Jay McCosh and Reid Washam. Also present: Town Administrator/Clerk Lesley Dellinger. Councilmembers Greg Richardson and Joe Rankin were out of town on business.

Mayor Robinette called the meeting to order. He stated the purpose of the meeting was to review and discuss the preliminary budget estimates for FY2019-20 and provide direction to staff.

Fire Chief, Lance Faulk, requested Council's consideration for additional funding to have the inside of the lower level of the McAdenville Fire Station painted. Cramerton Police Chief Adams submitted his budget request for the 2019 Christmas Safety Patrol for consideration. Council discussed the idea of adding an additional officer post at the intersection of Main & Mockingbird.

Lesley Dellinger presented Council with the projections for Water/Sewer fund expenditures and requested feedback on allocations. Council asked for clarification on the DWI loan rate associated with the South Fork Sewer Project and requested additional information on repayment of monies borrowed from the Town's general fund from previous years. Staff then provided updates on items from the March workshop including the 5% increase for the interlocal agreement with the Town of Cramerton for police and fire protection and the \$4,600 increase for single audit prep and professional services with Butler & Stowe.

There being no further business to discuss the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 6:58 PM.
